Turfgrass and Fairways:

Apply 30 lbs. of **Nature's Creation® Fungicide with Corn Meal Horticultural Grade** per 1,000 sq. ft. (3 lbs. per 100 sq. ft.) Spread over the affected area and two feet outside the area to prevent further spreading of the disease. Apply every 10 days or as needed. Only apply in areas where disease is present.

Annual and Perennial Bed Preparation:

Mix 3 lbs. of **Nature's Creation® Fungicide with Corn Meal Horticultural Grade** per 100 square feet of bed area (30 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.). This will aid in the prevention of soilborne disease.

Garden Ponds and Tanks:

For the control of floating paint-like and filamentous algae apply 5 - 7 lbs. of **Nature's Creation® Fungicide with Corn Meal Horticultural Grade** per 1,000 sq. ft. or 300 lbs. per acre of surface water in garden ponds and tanks with no outlets to other surface waters.

To make a spray solution, soak one cup of **Nature's Creation® Fungicide with Corn Meal Horticultural Grade** in one gallon of water overnight. Strain the solution thoroughly and spray affected or susceptible plants. Note: Use this solution immediately and do not store. It is very bio-active and will begin to ferment.
